To our Valued Customers and Suppliers,

As we continue to monitor the rapidly evolving situation around the Coronavirus (COVID-19), our first thoughts are for the safety and well-being of everyone. In these unprecedented times, it is important that we come together to support all those impacted.

On Wednesday, March 25th, the Governor of Minnesota declared a shelter-in-place order. This order goes into effect on Friday, March 27, at 11:59 pm. All non-essential businesses will be closed for at least two weeks at that time. As an essential business, we will continue operations.

Construction projects for health care facilities, data centers, waste treatment facilities, and most other businesses identified as part of the sixteen critical sectors by the Department of Homeland Security Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) rely on our products. Our primary raw material suppliers are already considered essential businesses as defined by CISA. This establishes us as a vital link in the supply chain for these projects, enabling us to continue production as an essential business.

Our top priority continues to be the safety of our employees and those of our customers and suppliers. We take this very seriously. Throughout the last two weeks we have taken aggressive measures, based on the CDC guidelines, to protect our employees. Most of our office personnel are already working remotely or practicing social distancing on site throughout our daily operations. With this order, all but our production team and handful of supervisory office employees will work from home. We will continue with all measures still in place.

We are currently working with our customers to prioritize work that supports critical infrastructure. Please note that much of the work that we do will qualify for this classification, and so we have a limited ability to shift schedules. Also, though we are operating as normally as possible, we may have unforeseen delays as we are insisting that our employees follow CDC guidelines for protecting and caring for themselves and family members.
